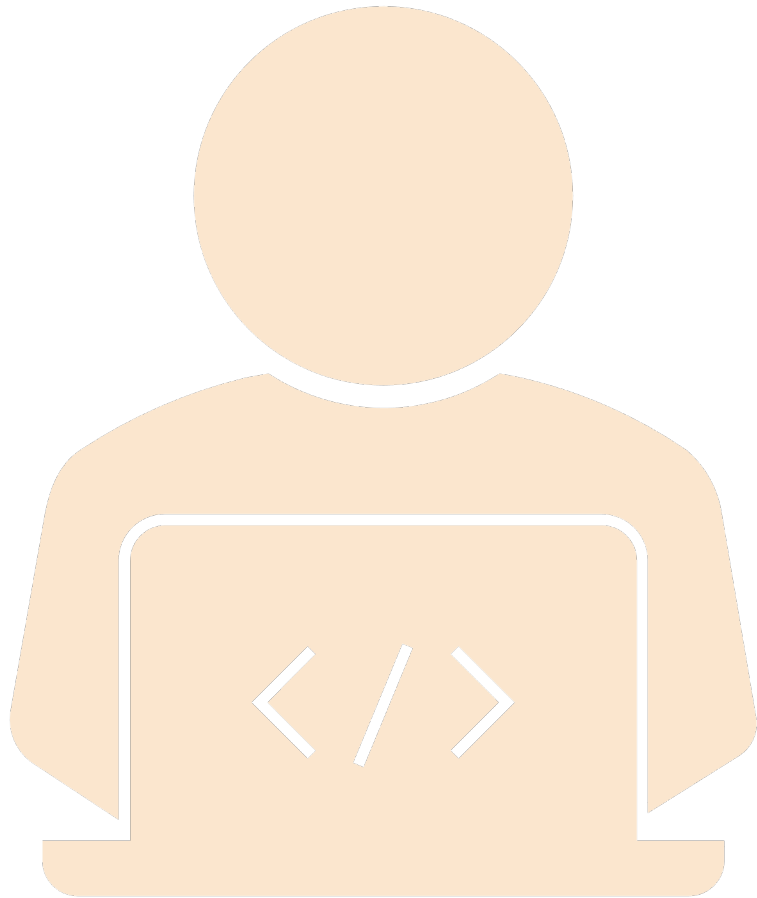

Technical Workshop


Day/Half-day sessions to understand various safety techniques and methodologies, report writing etc.
